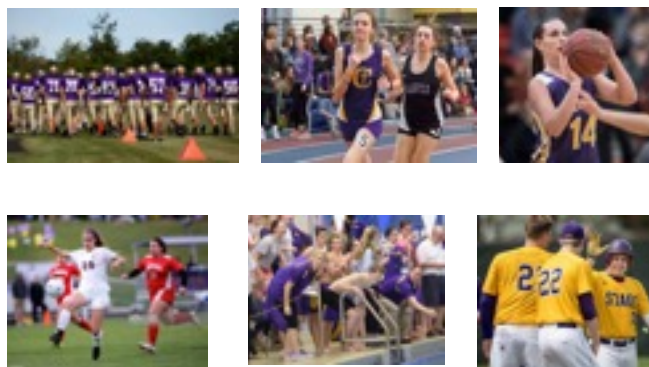

**Fundraising**

The primary source of funding for Purple & Gold include monies received from ticket sales at athletic and performing arts events, concessions, programing advertisement, craft fair, fall mum sale, big raffles and the Stag Stampede.

**Distribution of Funds**
